Longevi-tea Lectures with Dr. David Lipschitz**

**(LITTLE ROCK, AR)** – The Arkansas Arts Center presents the second and third lectures in the Longevi-tea Education Series on Friday, January 29 at 7:30 a.m. and Friday, February 12, 2010 at 3 p.m., both at the Arkansas Arts Center Lecture Hall. The Longevi-tea Education Series is presented by The Longevity Center at St. Vincent.

The January lecture, *Love and Passion in the 1<sup>st</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> Centuries*, presented by Dr. David Lipschitz, M.D., Executive Director of the Longevity Center at St. Vincent and Nan Plummer, Executive Director of the Arkansas Arts Center, will explore the romantic lives of the ancient Egyptians and how it relates to love today.
